The applicant must have served or is currently providing community service at a nonprofit organization of choice such as, but not exclusive to: Forks Visitor Center; Timber Museum; Forks Food Bank; Windfall; Forks Chamber of Commerce; and/or as a participating member of one of the following committees: 4th of July Committee; Twinkle Light Parade

Scholarship Application Package Requirements:

1. Package must be received by the deadline, April 16th
2. Include a Cover Letter stating your wishes for a scholarship from FCC. Summarize how this funding will impact your educational / career goals. Explain how these goals will empower you and your community.
3. Provide two letters of recommendation (one from a Teacher/Mentor AND one from your Volunteer Program Supervisor)
4. Include FHS profile
5. Most recent FHS transcript
